<b>Bleeding</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Recognition of profuse bleeding and adequate steps to reduce exsanguination</li> <li>- Application / Demonstration of pressure bandages</li> <li>- Application / Demonstration of CAT Tourniquet</li> <li>- Application / Demonstration of proper wound packing</li> </ul>	1	ALS BLS
<b>Trauma</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Perform a rapid trauma assessment during critical care treatment priorities</li> <li>- Provide care to a patient with a chest injury</li> <li>- Provide care to a patient with an open abdominal injury</li> </ul>	1	ALS BLS
<b>Patient Assessment / Treatment Priorities</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Recognition of treatment priorities (direct/indirect patient care, TACEVAC)</li> <li>- Ability/ Demonstration of patient assessments of treatment priorities /Triage</li> </ul>	1	ALS BLS
